

2020 BCDC Website Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.bcdcofak.org and Breast Cancer Detection Center of Alaska, and governs data collection and usage. For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to the Breast Cancer Detection Center of Alaska include www.bcdcofak.org and BCDC. The BCDC website is a news and information site where you can also purchase tickets and register for events and make donations. By using the BCDC website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with products and services offered at our site, BCDC may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- Mailing Address
- Email Address
- Phone Number

If you purchase BCDC products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

BCDC may also collect anonymous demographic information which is not unique to you such as your:

- Age
- Gender

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services available on the site. These may include a) registering for an account on our site, b) sending us an email message, c) entering a contest sponsored by us or one of our partners d) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing products and services on our site. To wit we will use your information for communicating with you in relation to services and or products you have requested from us. We also may gather personal or non- personal information in the future.

Use of your Personal Information

BCDC collects and uses your personal information to operate its website and deliver services you have requested.

BCDC may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other services available from BCDC.

BCDC does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

BCDC may disclose your personal information without notice, if required to do so by law or in good faith belief that such action is necessary to a) conform to the edicts of law or comply with legal process served on BCDC or the site, b) protect and defend the rights of or property of BCDCV and or c) act under exigent circumstance to protect personal safety of users of BCDC, or the public.

Site Security

We monitor visits to the Web site to identify any attempt to tamper with it.

When you submit personal information using our Web site — for example, if you sign up for a donation online — we have systems that make sure people outside of BCDC cannot access your personal information.

Tampering with BCDC's Web site is against the law. If anyone tries to tamper with it, they may be punished under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act of 1986.

Tracking User Behavior

BCDC may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within BCDC, in order to determine what BCDC services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within BCDC to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by BCDC. This information can include your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding the use of the BCDC website.

We encourage our users to be aware when they leave our site to read the privacy statements of any other sites that collect personally identifiable information.

Children Under Thirteen

BCDC does not collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parents for permission to use this website.

Email Communications

When you send us E-mail we won't keep or share your E-mail address with anyone outside of FCFB staff and its contractors. If you sign up for one of our (E)mailing lists we will send you periodic information on the FCFB and will request donations via email, as well.
